The Liberatus study is seeking volunteers to participate in a clinical research study that will look at the effectiveness, durability, safety, and tolerability of the study drug when compared to placebo (no active ingredients) to treat the symptoms of lactose intolerance—your ability to eat lactose containing foods, like dairy, without discomfort.

You must meet these criteria* to participate:

- 18-75 years of age
- Current or recent history of intolerance to milk and other dairy products for at least 1 month
- No gastrointestinal disorders that could interfere with the study, including Crohn's disease, irritable bowel syndrome, inflammatory bowel disease, ulcerative colitis, Celiac disease, chronic constipation

*Other criteria will apply.
