ONWARDS

ONWARDS is a global programme of clinical studies to investigate how well a new investigational insulin taken once weekly, insulin icodec, controls blood sugar in people with diabetes. Once-weekly insulin icodec will be compared with insulins taken once daily, which are already available on the market.

As part of the programme, this long-term study is comparing the effect and safety of once-weekly insulin icodec, with that of daily insulin glargine, over a period of 20 months.

You may qualify for this study if you are an adult with type 2 diabetes who has not yet received insulin treatment.
