

Is your blood pressure medication not working?

If your blood pressure is high despite blood pressure medication, find out if you qualify for the HALO study.



The goal of the HALO study is to find out if a study drug can safely lower blood pressure in adults with uncontrolled hypertension (high blood pressure). *Uncontrolled* means a person's blood pressure is high, even though they are taking a medication for it.

Eligible study participants receive at no cost:

- Possible access to a study drug
 - Some participants will receive a placebo, which has no active ingredients.
 - Participants who receive a placebo during the first part of the study may be able to take the study drug in the second part if they meet certain criteria.
- Current blood pressure medication (paid for by the study)
- Possible compensation for time and travel
- Study support and monitoring by a healthcare team
- Information about high blood pressure
